

Ngorongoro Conservation Area





- A UNESCO World Heritage Site, celebrated for its natural beauty & biodiversity.
- An area where wildlife coexists with human settlements (Maasai people).
- Home to several volcanic peaks and calderas, including the famous Ngorongoro Crater.
- A diverse range of ecosystems supporting a wide variety of species.
- Ideal safari destination with over 30,000 large animals, including the Big Five.

The Ngorongoro Conservation Area spans over 8,300 sq. km and acts as a vital wildlife corridor for the annual Great Migration, as millions of wildebeest, zebras and other herbivores pass through.

- 1 Big Five: Lions, elephants, rhinos, leopards, and buffalo.
- Dense Population: High density of wildlife within the crater.
- **3 Endangered Species:** Black rhinos are commonly sighted.
- 4 Flamingos: Seasonal presence in crater lakes.
- **5** Zebras & Wildebeest: Frequent grazers on the crater floor.

Ngorongoro Conservation Area

The **Ngorongoro Conservation Area** is home to over 500 bird species, both migratory and resident, thriving in diverse vegetation. Many water birds can be found at Lake Magadi on the crater floor.
