





## Location and Geography




**Tarangire National Park**, situated south of Lake Manyara, lies between the Masai Steppe and the Great Rift Valley Lakes in northern Tanzania.

✓ **Landscapes:** Grasslands, baobab trees, and riverine woodlands.

✓ **Facts:** Sausage trees are key resting spots for lions and leopards.



# Reaching to **Tarangire** **National Park**



**Tarangire National Park**, part of the Northern Safari Circuit, is a few hours' drive from Arusha and accessible by road or charter flights.

✓ **By Air:** Fly to Kilimanjaro or Arusha; charter flights available.

✓ **By Road:** 3-hour drive from Arusha.



## When to Visit **Tarangire** **National Park?**



The best time to visit Tarangire National Park is from late June to October during the dry season. This period offers optimal conditions for game viewing as wildlife congregates around water sources.

### Month-wise Best Time

**Jan-Mar:** Ideal for birdwatching and scenic views.

**Apr-May:** Fewer crowds, lower costs; good for birdwatching.

**Jun-Oct:** Best for wildlife sightings during dry season.

**Nov-Dec:** Green season with lush landscapes.



# Wildlife in the **Tarangire** **National Park**



## Elephants:

Large herds, up to 300+.



## Lions:

Often seen resting in trees.



## Antelopes:

Includes gerenuks and oryxes.



## Wildlife:

Diverse species like leopards, hippos, and zebras.



# Attractions in the Tarangire National Park?

Now that you know why you should visit Tarangire National Park, it's time to move on to the next step, i.e. the major attractions of the park. Below we'll go over each of them in detail:



## Silale Swamp:

Major water source attracting wildlife.



## Baobab Trees:

Huge trees vital for animals.

## Migration:

Seasonal movement of herbivores and predators.



## Elephants:

Large herds, up to 300 individuals.



## Poacher's Hide:

Historic baobab tree with a hidden chamber.

## Entry Fee

The **Tanzania National Parks Authority (TANAPA)** manages and conserves Tanzania's national parks. They set entry fees and guidelines for park visitors.

Entrance fees	In High season	In Low Season
<b>Residents</b>	\$29	\$26
<b>Non- Residents</b>	\$59	\$53
<b>Children (5 to 15 age) Residents</b>	\$8	Same price as the high season
<b>Children (5 to 15 age) Non- Residents</b>	\$17	Same price as the high season
