

Lake Manyara National Park is located between the Great Rift Valley and Lake Manyara and is a protected area in Tanzania's Arusha and Manyara regions.

How to get there?

- ✓ **By Road:** 2 hours from Arusha
- ✓ **By Air:** Flights to Manyara airstrip from Kilimanjaro & Arusha airports
- ✓ **Public Transport:** Bus to Mto wa Mbu, then rent a car.

WHEN TO VISIT

LAKE MANYARA NATIONAL PARK?

Lake Manyara National Park receives two main seasons in a year- the dry season and the wet season. Each season has its share of benefits and unique offerings.



Dry Seasons:

Best for wildlife spotting
(Jan-Feb & Jun-Oct).



Wet Seasons:

Lush scenery and birdwatching
(Nov & April-May).



Wildlife in Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park is famous for birdwatching but also boasts some of Africa's largest mammal populations. It's a prime spot for both avian and wildlife viewing.



- Big Five: All except rhinos; notable for elephants.
- Wildlife: Baboons, giraffes, lions, hippos, and more.





Birdlife in the Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park is a must-visit destination for bird lovers with over 400 different species! Here is a taste of what you might find:

- 
Flamingos:
 The park's alkaline lake attracts thousands of lesser and greater flamingo
- 
Pelicans:
 Both great white pelicans and pink-backed pelicans are commonly seen resting on the water.
- 
Kingfishers:
 Several species can be spotted near the water's edge
- 
Crowned Hornbills:
 These large, striking birds are often seen in the forested areas of the park
- 
African Fish Eagle:
 Known for its iconic call, the African fish eagle is a common sight
- 
Sacred Ibis:
 Frequently seen foraging in the shallows.
- 
Grey Heron:
 A common sight in the park, wading through the water or standing still, waiting to catch fish.
- 
Yellow-billed Stork:
 These large wading birds are often seen near the water.
- 
Great Egret:
 Often seen wading through shallow waters, hunting for fish and insects.



Attractions of Lake Manyara National Park

Tree-Climbing Lions:

Lions lounging in acacia trees.

2



Flamingos:

The alkaline lake attracts thousands of flamingos creating a stunning pink panorama.

Elephants:

Large populations near water.

4



Baboons:

Large troops of baboons are commonly found around the park's forests and water sources.

Bird Species:

Over 400 species, ideal for birdwatching.

Game Drives:

Spot giraffes, zebras, and lions by day.

Night Drives:

See nocturnal animals like leopards and jackals.

Canoeing:

Observe hippos and water birds.

Walking Safaris:

Enjoy birdwatching and views from above.





Entrance Fees to Lake Manyara National Park

Lake Manyara National Park entry fees vary by citizenship. Residents and non-residents pay different rates for access to the park.

Category	Entrance Fees (for ages 16 yrs. And above)	Entrance Fees (for individuals from the ages of 5 to 15 yrs.)
Residents	High Season: 29.50 USD- Low Season: 26.55 USD	8.85 USD
Non-Residents	High Season: 59 USD- Low Season: 53.10 USD	17.70 USD





