Before diving into the cost of your Kilimanjaro climbing expedition, let's first explore the flight expenses to consider when planning your trip.

Factors that Influence the Cost



Group Size:

Larger groups lower individual costs.



Duration:

Longer climbs are more expensive.



Service Level:

Costs vary, from classic treks to luxury treks



Costs By Route

The cost of climbing Kilimanjaro varies according to the chosen route. Below are approximate prices for a classic climb on the 5 different routes, ranging from 1 to 4 climbers in the same group.

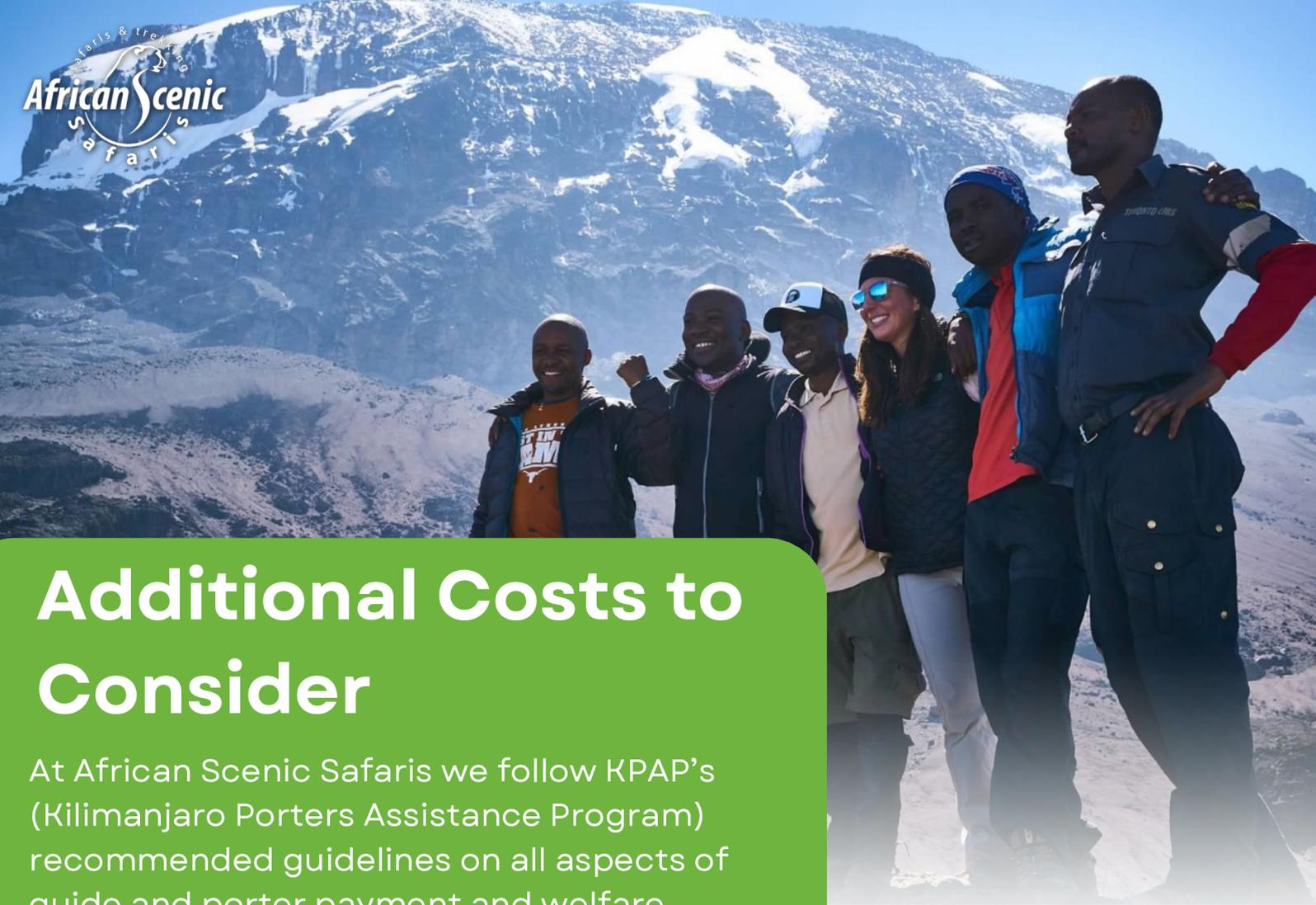

6 Days Marangu Route	\$2,930	\$2,380	\$2,350	\$2,235
7 Days Machame Route	\$3,305	\$2,710	\$2,600	\$2,535
7 Days Rongai Route	\$3,515	\$2,790	\$2,680	\$2,590
8 Days Lemosho Route	\$3,840	\$3,095	\$3,000	\$2,920
9 Days Northern Circuit Route	\$4,330	\$3,425	\$3,340	\$3,260



Cost Breakdown
